

Seville, Spain Semester Study Abroad 2017-2018

This cost sheet outlines the program costs associated with the semester study abroad program in Seville, Spain at International College of Seville through ICISP. ICISP reserves the reight to modify program costs due to significant exchange rate fluctuations.

Program Dates:

Fall: Sept 20, 2017 – Dec 15, 2017 Spring: Jan 31, 2018 – May 11, 2018

Application Deadline:

Applications must be submitted to ICISP by May 15 (Fall) or October 15 (Spring, visa required).

Payment:

A \$500 deposit is due with the student's application. The remaining balance (\$9,250) is due to the student's home college no later than the date of pre-departure orientation. All payments must be made to the student's home college. The student's home college will then remit payment to ICISP. Questions regarding financial aid and/or payments should be directed to the student's ICISP representative.

Note – Required Spanish health insurance (private clinics, medical specialists, house calls, 24-hr. support service) is included in the ICS tuition. Included in the Orientation/Culture fees are: airport reception for designated flights, Wi-Fi access at ICS, "intercambios" with Spanish students, cultural excursions, field trips, orientation, flamenco show and tapas dinner, Seville walking tour with churros and chocolate, belly dancing and exotic teas evening, Spanish cooking classes, Flamenco classes, holiday celebrations and the end of term party.
